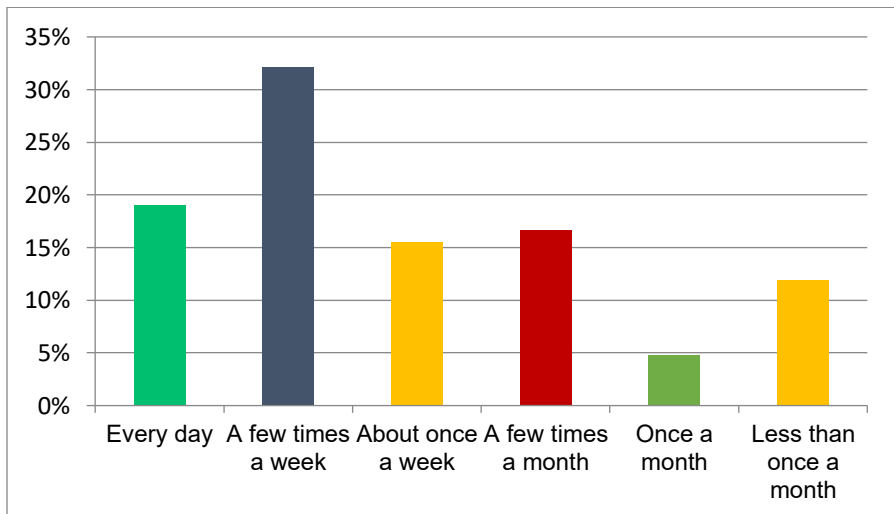
Results from the survey for the Lethbridge Memorial Recreation Field – summary of results

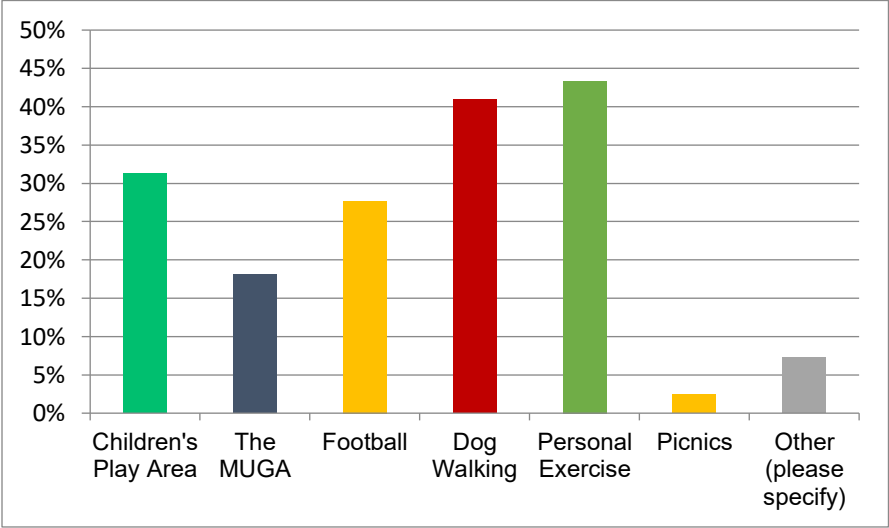
A total of 84 responses were received which is a very good response rate for a voluntary questionnaire.

The parish council will be discussing the priorities at their September council meeting which will be held on 18th September at 7.30 pm in the village hall.

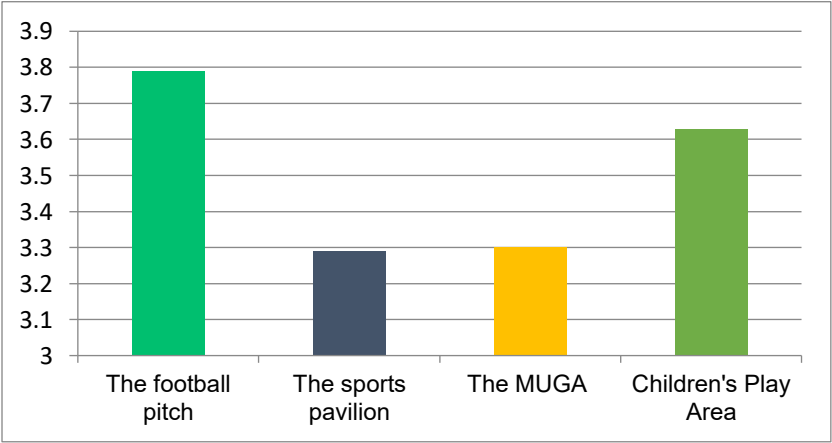
How often do you use the recreation field?



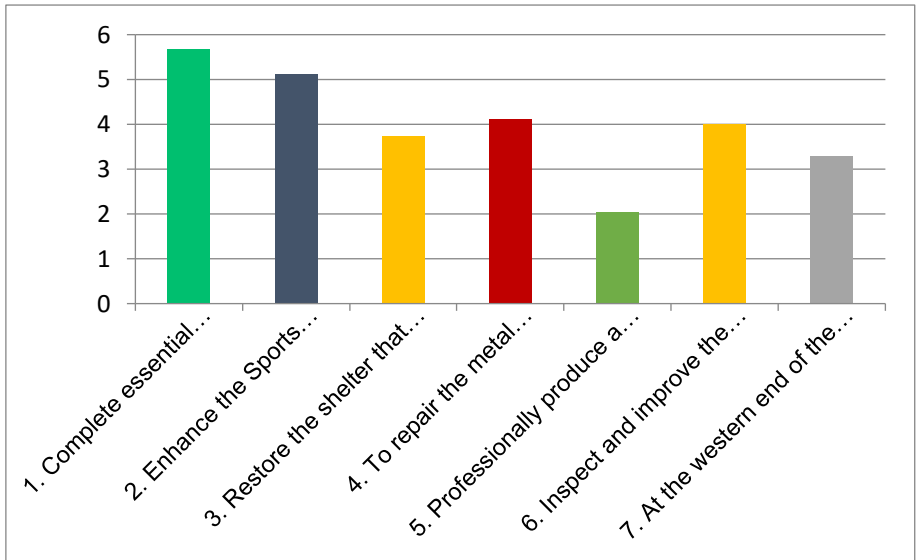
What do you use the recreation field for? Please select all that apply



The following facilities are available at the Lethbridge recreation ground. Which is the most important?



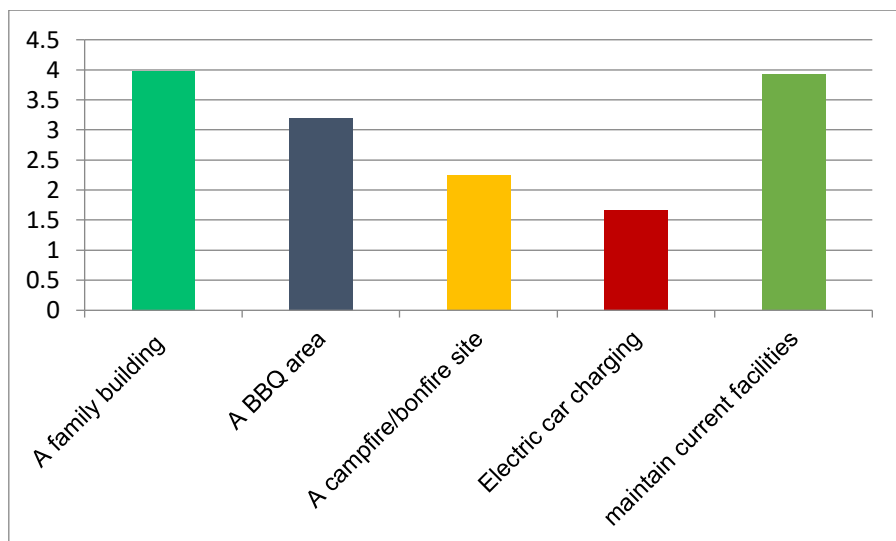
What improvements to the existing facilities at the recreation field should the parish council prioritise? The options scored as below.



The options were:

1. Complete essential repairs to the sports pavilion
2. Enhance sports pavilion with a complete renovation and extension of the building to increase the usage as a resource for community hire
3. Restore the shelter that was previously at the western end of the field
4. Repair the metal framed benches and place at the western end of the field
5. Professionally produce a notice board to inform people of the history of the field
6. Improve the existing woodland at the western end. Replace diseased trees and plant woodland bulbs
7. Plant a 'coronation' line of English trees at the western end and plant wildflowers on the bank
