Restore the shelter that was previously positioned at the centre of the western end of the recreation field. This was known as The Haw's Memorial Shelter.

Professionally produce a notice board to inform people of the History of the Lethbridge Memorial Ground	
Inspect and improve the existing woodland at the western end of the recreation field. Replace diseased trees and plant woodland bulbs.
